To All Employees and Dependents:

The North Central States Regional Council of Carpenters' Health Fund (the "Plan") is furnishing you this Notice as required by federal law. In most cases, the information presented in this Notice will have a limited application to employees (and dependents) eligible for Plan coverage. It may apply if you are required to pay a premium for coverage under the Plan. If you believe the information in the Notice applies to your situation, you should contact the applicable office in the state where you reside as shown in the attached listing.

If you or your dependents are eligible for Medicaid or CHIP and also are eligible for health coverage from your employer, your state may have a premium assistance program that can help pay for coverage, using funds from their Medicaid or CHIP programs. If you or your dependents are not eligible for Medicaid or CHIP, you will not be eligible for these premium assistance programs, but you may be able to buy individual insurance coverage through the Health Insurance Marketplace. For more information, visit: www.healthcare.gov.

If you or your dependents already are enrolled in Medicaid or CHIP and you live in a state listed in the attachment, contact your state Medicaid or CHIP office to find out if premium assistance is available.

If you or your dependents are NOT currently enrolled in Medicaid or CHIP, and you think you or any of your dependents might be eligible for either of these programs, contact your state Medicaid or CHIP office or dial **1-877-KIDS NOW** or www.insurekidsnow.gov to find out how to apply. If you qualify, you can ask your state if it has a program that might help you pay the premiums for an employer-sponsored plan.

If you or your dependents are eligible for premium assistance under Medicaid or CHIP, as well as eligible under your employer plan, your employer must allow you to enroll in your employer plan if you are not already enrolled. This is called a "special enrollment" opportunity, and **you must request coverage within 60 days of being determined eligible for premium assistance**.
